Who is Pack 196?

Pack 196 is sponsored by the Mabel Rush parent group, and is the longest existing Cub Scout pack in the Newberg area.

Who can join Pack 196?

Any boy in grades 1-5, from any school or home-school. Each boy also needs to have an adult who commits to being part of the program alongside them.

How is Cub Scouts structured?

All the boys together form the PACK. We gather for a fun PACK meeting once a month, and also do other activities as a PACK.
